

Acrylics Supplies List

Goldens, Winsor Newton, Liquitex are better quality paints.-they have paint kits where they sell sets for mixing colors

Basics or Galeria, are good too, less expensive.-they also have sets as well
Paint kits from Michaels are ok, but paint quality is cheap, not as good.

I usually like to work with these colors:

Ultramarine Blue
Cadmium Yellow -light and/or deep
Alizarin Crimson
Cadmium red
Burnt Siena
Titanium White
Pthalo Blue

Other colors or variations are fine too, a lot of kits will have different colors but similar to what I use! If you have a limited color pallet, it is better for mixing.

Sable brushes are great for acrylics. Having a variety of sizes is good to have- flats, pointed, large and small. Can usually find sets that say for acrylics, and can get a good variety for a decent price.

Brush case or something to hold and protect them.

Paper towels

Pallet- disposable are nice, but plastic pallets work well too.
